### **Required Submittals at Time of Application**

**New or Additions to Residential or Commercial/Industrial Structures**

**Residential Accessory Buildings 200 sq. ft. and greater, Decks**

Permit application

1 complete set of building plans, 1 copy of site plan drawn to scale (size 11X17), showing proposed construction

**Interior Remodel or Build-outs of Commercial/Industrial Structures**

Permit Application

1 complete set of building plans, 1 copy of site plan drawn to scale/show parking plan (size 11X17)

**Fences, Accessory Buildings/Sheds smaller than 200 sq. ft. Residential swimming pools and spas**

Permit Application

1 copy of a survey or site plan drawn to scale (size 11X17), showing proposed construction

**Signs larger than 3 sq. ft.**

Permit Application

1 copy of sign drawn to scale, site plan drawn to scale showing the location of the sign (size 11X17)

### **Permit Fee Schedule**

Residential New Construction.....	\$100.00
Residential Additions .....	\$30.00
Residential Accessory Buildings, Sheds, Barns and Other Outbuildings.....	\$30.00
Commercial / Industrial New Construction.....	\$500.00
Commercial / Industrial Additions.....	\$150.00
Commercial / Industrial Build Out or Remodeling.....	\$50.00
Fences, Decks and other minor Construction.....	\$20.00
Signs larger than 3 sq. ft.....	\$20.00
Swimming Pools/Spas.....	\$30.00

**\*\*For other construction not above described, fees will be in the reasonable discretion of the Zoning Officer\*\***

***“No Zoning Review or permit fees are required by The Village of Campton Hills for Residential Repairs (Re-Roof, Siding, Residential Interior Remodeling such as basements, kitchens and Alterations such as dormers.)Permits for the above are required by Kane County”***
