

MINUTES OF THE AUGUST 13, 2008, MEETING OF THE  
COMMUNITY RELATIONS CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD  
OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS

- I. Call to Order. Chairman Linda Bauman called the meeting to order at 6:10 P.M.
- II. Roll Call. Present: Bill Beith, Karen Dowd, Tom Dowd, Sue Windland and Linda Bauman. Absent: Jim Kopec and Meghan Staskal-Bradt.

- III. Minutes of the August 6, 2008, meeting were unanimously approved.
- IV. Comments from the Public: None

Karen Dowd made a motion to adjourn and move the meeting to her home. Motion was seconded by Bill Beith and approved by unanimous voice vote. A notice with the new location's address was posted.

The meeting was reconvened and called to order at 6:45 P.M. by Chairman Bauman.

- V. Discussion of the Farmer's Market. With the addition of two new vendors, we now have six participating regularly at our Market. They are: Martin's Certified Organic Farm, Erewhon Farm, Schramer's Black Angus Farm, Phil and Karen Stojan's Vegetables, Debbie and Rob Murphy's Curds 'n Whey cheese, and Randy and Gail Robert's Majestic Nursery.

Sue Windland and Linda Bauman counted 140 shoppers at the Market on Saturday, August 9. Good weather, more available produce, weekly e-newsletters and hard work by Sue is contributing to the market's success.

Sue explained to the committee that she would like to have an "appreciation" luncheon for our market vendors on Saturday, September 20, at the market grounds immediately after closing. It would be a simple cookout with food provided by our committee. Sue made a motion to have the luncheon, Tom Dowd seconded, and the committee approved it by unanimous voice vote.

- VI. Discussion of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Heritage Farm Fest. Some adjustments were made to the schedule of stage entertainers. The new schedule is as follows:

Don will also design and print a two-sided flier advertising the Fest, which the committee will place in the windows of local businesses and the Farmer's Market vendor's booths.
