February 1, 2012**

**I. Call to Order**

Commissioner Nowicki called the meeting to order at 7:54 p.m.

**II. Roll Call**

Present: Commissioners Dennis Nowicki, Emad Eassa, Christian Boissonnas

**III. New Business**

- a. Review and act upon an Initial Eligibility Register for applicants for police officer for the Village of Campton Hills.

Boissonnas moved approval of the Initial Eligibility Register of the applicants successfully completing the Orientation, Written Test, Physical Agility Test, and Oral Interview for the position of full-time police officer in the Village of Campton Hills. Eassa seconded. The motion passed on a roll call: Boissonnas, aye; Eassa, aye; Nowicki, aye.

The Board discussed whether the scores should be posted or just the names in rank order. It decided to post the composite scores of all applicants who attained a composite score above 70, but not the written test or interview scores. Further, the Board decided that applicants on the list had to communicate their request for preference points and supporting documentation within 10 days of the posting of the Preliminary Eligibility Register. The Board will post the register on 6 February 2012.

- b. Review and act upon the appointment of a sergeant for the Village of Campton Hills.


