AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VILLAGE CODE SECTION 1-7-11B-2

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois that:

Section 1. Section 1-7-11 Paragraph B. 2. is hereby amended and restated to provide as follows:

2. Vacation Schedule: Each regular employee who works on an average (on a fiscal year basis) of 32 hours or more hours per week shall be entitled to equivalent paid vacation for such fiscal year as follows:

<u>Years Of Service</u>	<u>Weeks' Paid Vacation</u>
1 to 5	2
6 to 15	3
Over 15	4

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval as required by law. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form.
