On September 22, 2008 the St. Charles Police Department responded to an injured person call, which was found to be a stabbing victim who later died at the hospital. Initial responding officers were able to determine where the incident occurred and secured the scene, as well as potential witnesses and suspects.

Due to the investigative work necessary, it became apparent that assistance was needed. The Kane County Major Crimes Task Force was called out to assist. Task Force members from yours and other departments responded to the callout. Investigators worked through the night and the following day, and by late afternoon those responsible for the death had been identified, interviewed and in custody, with charges being authorized.

The response demonstrated the benefit of collaboration to bring this case to a timely conclusion. We are fortunate to be a part of the Major Crimes Task Force receiving this help when needed. Please share our appreciation for the assistance your agency provided with your personnel who helped.
