Attached please find the amended GIS file for the 4,481 parcels within the Village of Campton Hills. The only thing I question about this file is that Elgin added another zip code for the area west of Randall and I have a feeling all the 60123s for Elgin should actually be 60124s. I assume the Post Office can let you know and then we can correct our files.

We discussed this briefly at the COW meeting and you should go ahead and work with the USPS to recognize the Campton Hills name for the data base attached. From this data base, I deleted all the CJR and Cartee parcels that have been disconnected and added in the address for Gustafson that we annexed last Tuesday.

After I know these are all keyed in, I'm going to ask you to help get the Realtors data base updated. I already have a contact there. We should probably also give this information to the 411 people. Thanks for your help with this project.

Update:

I just spoke with Norene McFadden at the AMS office for our area - covers all 5 zips. She indicates getting Campton Hills added could happen in less than one week pending delivery of some info (see below). The process they perform adds Campton Hills to their DBs; however, this info must then get 'distributed' to other DBs and this could take some more time. But they maintain the central DB with all official 'valid' USPS addresses.

They need a fax copy of our 'articles of incorp' or whatever they are called that officially says we are a village/city in the state of Illinois.

Fax# 630-XXX-XXXX

They then want an Excel file emailed to Norene that contains street address (number and street name), current city name (if not known that is ok), and zip code. They explicitly do NOT want any person names or other identifying info on this list though. And if we have 'street ranges' instead that would suffice too. She indicates they can work with most any format though, so we have latitude there. Just needs to be a 'close' to complete list so they have the most detailed info for 'who' is now in Campton Hills for their DB.

I wanted to mention that the post office systems maintain an electronic record of every city/zip combination that is 'allowed'. We can apply to have this list updated so Campton Hills will be automatically handled by their electronic sorting systems. We would have to do this for each of the 5 zips.

This does not mean Campton Hills has a zip, it just means we are recognized as valid in these 'other' zips.

ZIP codes plentiful in Campton Hills

CAMPTON HILLS - Geneva and Batavia have one ZIP code each, and St. Charles has two, but the year-old Village of Campton Hills has five - count 'em - five.

And now that the village's 22.5 square miles are incorporated, some might think it would have its own, single postal delivery code.

ZIP code, short for Zone Improvement Plan, serves mail delivery needs, not municipal identity needs.

And village officials have not asked for their own ZIP code, postal authorities say.

"At this time, they are not going to get their own ZIP code or post office," said Norene McFadden, acting manager of address management systems for the northern Illinois for the U.S. Postal Service. "They will remain getting delivery from the post offices they are now."

Campton Hills' five ZIP codes are:

- St. Charles , 60175

- Elburn, 60119

- Elgin , 60124

- Hampshire, 60140

- Wasco, 60183

Deputy Clerk William Beith said if someone were to stand with one foot inside the Wasco Post Office and one foot outside, he would be standing the St. Charles and Wasco ZIP codes simultaneously.

"It's sort of like the Continental Divide," Beith said. "A ZIP code is up to the post office. At some point between now and 2040, the post office will probably make that determination."

The Wasco Post Office has post office boxes and sells stamps, the same as a full-service post office, Postmaster Barby Kay said. It does not deliver mail.

Village Trustee Al Lenkaitis, Jr., said there is no reason to get a single ZIP code, because residents can use Campton Hills with any one of the five ZIP codes and get their mail just fine.

However, Kay said the postal machinery will not recognize Campton Hills as a valid address, so mail addressed that way has to be processed by hand.
