Fox Mill/Campton Crossings Disconnection Petition Withdrawn & Dismissed

The Village is pleased that the residents who signed the Fox Mill/Campton Crossings petition to disconnect, voluntarily withdrew their petition this morning before Judge Michael Colwell. The Village is grateful that Village funds will no longer be expended to challenge the sufficiency and ultimately the merits of this petition. As a result of the dismissal of this petition, the 2,318 residents will remain part of the Village.

We are thankful that Trustees Laura Andersen and Sue George, Fire and Police Commission members Dennis Nowicki and Emad Eassa, Plan Commission member Jay Richardson, Zoning Board of Appeals member Kathleen Judy and Public Works Committee member Ray Ulreich, all of whom reside in Fox Mill or Campton Crossings, will be able to continue to serve the community.

Earlier this week the Village Board directed the Village attorneys to withdraw the Sunset Villa disconnection appeal currently pending before the Appellate Court. The Sunset Villa disconnection petition is estimated to include 124 residents who will no longer be a part of the Village, unless they choose to annex back in.

After the second affirmation of the Village by the electors who voted to sustain the Village of Campton Hills last Tuesday, the Village Board is focusing its efforts on expeditiously resolving the remaining disconnection petitions. With the election behind us, the Village Board is moving forward and is committed to unifying our community.
