### **Appellate Court Decision Only Affects 5% of Campton Hills' Population**

The Appellate Court issued a comprehensive decision consisting of 24 pages in upholding Judge Colwell's rulings in five disconnection cases. The decision will serve to provide guidelines to the courts in future disconnection matters on a number of issues that had not been decided in reported cases in the past.

Campton Hills Village President Patsy Smith stated, "While we had hoped to prevail in these five cases, they involve a total of 708 people, only 5% of the 13,483 Village population. We will review the decision and its impact on other pending disconnection cases at Tuesday's Village Board meeting."

President Smith also noted that the pending disconnection cases have very different legal issues from those just decided. She stated, "The Village Board will evaluate the possibility of a rehearing of the Appellate Court decision, but personally, I would be surprised if our Board took any further action."

Smith noted that the Village recently learned, that under the rules applied by the State of Illinois, the revenue currently received by the Village from the State Shared Revenue will continue until sometime in 2011 after the 2010 Census has been certified.
