Burning Brush and Snow Information

Burning Rules

-Brush is the only material that can legally be burned in most areas of the Village.

- Brush includes: tree trunks, limbs, branches, and twigs.

-Brush may be burned in two manners:

1. Recreational fires are allowed any time, as long as they are no larger than 3' x 3' x 3'
2. Larger piles of brush may be burned only under certain conditions:
 - A. Sunny Day
 - B. Between 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM
 - C. Wind Speed is less than 10 MPH
 - D. Brush shall be dry when burned
 - E. Burning is not permitted on public or private roads, alleys, sidewalks or easements
 - F. Must be supervised
 - G. Cannot be within 20 FT of any structure of property line
 - H. A fire extinguisher or water source shall be available at the burning site
 - I. It is the owners responsibility to determine satisfactory conditions for burning

Snow Removal

-Please keep cars off the street until a storm is done and your street has been plowed

-Snow plows will discharge snow to the curbside of the street and inevitably into some driveways; if you can delay shoveling your driveway until the street has been plowed you will save yourself a lot of hassle.

-If your mailbox is accidently knocked over the township will replace your mailbox with a standard 4 x 4 wood post mailbox or reimburse the homeowner \$75.00 for a new one. Call (630) 365-9300 if this happens.

Brush Information

Brush Pick-Up Guidelines

- Occurs twice a year
- To find out when pick-up will be in your area:
 - Call Village Hall or The Campton Township Highway District
 - Check online at:
 - www.villageofcamptonhills.org
 - www.camptontownship.com
- Maximum accepted measurements:
 - Diameter for tree limbs is 18 inches
 - Length 8 feet
- Piled neatly, cut ends facing the road
- Small twigs should be tied together
- *Do Not Include Any Type Of Waste Items*
- *Brush should be placed by the road **Sunday** before your scheduled brush pick-up week; The Highway District will by pass by only once*

Tree and Brush Trimming

- Due to the high volume of Emerald Ash Borer, it will not be included in brush pick-up. It is the responsibility of the homeowner to contact a private contractor for proper disposal.
- Brush is defined as trimmings from bushes or shrubs, as well as tree branches from trimming or pruning of trees.
- Cutting down a tree is not considered to be trimming or pruning, and will not be accepted by the Highway District for removal.
- It is the responsibility of the homeowner to properly dispose of their trees.
